In this Newsletter we will focus on MVP & Final Score as these wagers have enormous profit potential. While we are firmly in the Chiefs camp, we cannot rule out a 49ers victory. Therefore, let's begin with our best bets for 49ERS:

MVP: If the 49ers win we see 2 generous possibilities for Most Valuable Player:

George Kittle at 15 to 1 odds - as well as Deebo Samuels with 26 to 1 odds.

FINAL SCORE: is our favorite proposition wager of the entire year, no matter the sport. This is because Final Score rewards on average 100x your stake i.e. \$10 wager returns \$1000. \*Please Note\* - with thousands of possibilities expectations should be lowered. Nevertheless, we like our chances...

SAN FRANCISCO 49ERS WIN: (scores are in order from strongest to weakest)

**31-30** (150x odds) 30-24 (90x odds)

21-20 (75x odds) **29-20** (175x odds) **31-16** (200x odds)

Now we turn to who we believe will be <u>Super Bowl LIV Champions</u>:

The heavily coded **Kansas City Chiefs**.



*MVP:* As per our Super Bowl Preview Newsletter, <u>Patrick Mahomes & Travis Kelce</u> are most likely to win MVP. Mahomes is the heavy Vegas favorite, & his odds do not meet our risk/reward requirements. Depending on your risk appetite - parlay Mahomes winning MVP with Chiefs winning the game.

However, <u>Travis Kelce</u> does have rewarding odds around 13 to 1. We want to <u>wager Kelce</u>, <u>AND include Mecole Hardman</u> as well for his favorable 51 to 1 odds. If there is a <u>surprise MVP</u> - it will be <u>Hardman</u>. As a reminder, Mahomes is most likely to win this category, & because of that we do not want to over-wager this proposition.

When it comes to **FINAL SCORES**, the **CHIEFS** are complex, & we have <u>10 potential Final Scores</u> for them: <u>4 Top Scores</u> along with <u>6 alternate Final Scores</u>. Picking your own favorite Final Score is also encouraged. Again, we push *Final Score* because the Odds present a Once-in-a-Year opportunity to hit an enormous Winner.

Patrick Mahomes =50. Cheetah =50. Clark Hunt & Goodell both born on 50th day of the year.


